

UPDATE Statement by Cllr Nigel Brooks Ward Councillor Highcliffe & Walkford

Summertime Parking Restrictions – Chewton Farm Estate area, Highcliffe

I am pleased to advise residents that following a concerted effort by residents, Parish Council Members, Highcliffe Residents Association (HRA) and others the **Zonal Parking Scheme** put forward by BCP Council, as set out in my Statement of 28th February is not going ahead. My particular thanks to resident Malcom Eastwood who has coordinated much of the dialogue with BCP Council.

The Scheme put forward had serious flaws and the conclusion was it was totally unacceptable to residents in the 15 roads affected where 230 chargeable parking bays were proposed. The scheme had not been properly thought through and could not be accepted on the 'take it or leave it' basis as presented.

Moving forward residents and representatives for our community will be looking to BCP Council for a constructive consultation period so that an acceptable way of tackling summertime parking in unrestricted residential roads can be achieved.

Thank you to everyone who has contacted Parish Members, HRA and myself. We will ensure that you are kept up to date with progress in the coming months.
